This classification continues to grow in payroll size reporting Actual Payroll of \$79.7M for 2023, up approximately 10% from the previous year. Approximately 31% of this payroll is certified.

A total of (15) Severe Injuries occurred in 2023, down (1) from the previous year. There was a fairly significant increase in Time Loss Injuries increasing from (65) to (79).

The previous year this classification was reassigned to the 200% Risk Category from the 150% Risk Category as claims costs incurred remains high. The costs are more reflective of costs within the 250% Risk Category and the classification is at risk of seeing a further increase in the not too distant future.
