This classification remains the third largest of levied classifications and saw an increase of 8% in Actual Payroll in 2023, now standing at \$248.6M. Approximately 67% of this payroll is safety certified.

Despite the increase in exposure hours, Severe Injuries continue to trend downwards at (20) in 2023 compared to (22) the previous year. There was a dramatic increase in Time Loss Injuries at (117) compared to (96) previously.

The classification comfortably remains in the 125% Risk Category where it has been for many years.
