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Although one of the smaller classifications there was significant payroll growth in 2023. Payroll rose from \$18.3M to \$21M or 15%. Approximately 59% of this payroll is safety certified.

The classification reported (1) Severe Injury and (2) Time Loss Injuries in 2023. It has shown recent movement from the 75% Risk Category to the 60% Risk Category. Tracking is ongoing and hopefully a trend develops.
