This classification is one of the smallest of classifications and is not levied. Actual Payroll dropped approximately 4% in 2023, to \$37.3M. About 11% of the payroll is safety certified.

Claims volumes remain high with (8) Severe Injuries in 2023 and 24 Time Loss Injuries. This classification is quickly tracking towards a newly assigned Risk Category. It currently resides in the 125% Risk Category, however has consistently shown claims costs at or above the 150% category.
