Initially Metal Products is one of the smaller levied classifications with Actual Payroll of approximately \$30M. 52% of this payroll is safety certified.

In 2024 the classification saw a significant reduction in Severe Injuries from 6 to 3 and Time Loss Injuries from 26 to 14. The classification has been assigned to the 300% Risk Category and is not trending in either direction.
