In 2024, this classification continues to see significant payroll growth of approximately 6% or \$66.2M. About 31% of this payroll is safety certified.

The classification saw increases in Severe Injuries from 8 to 11 and Time Loss Injuries from 34 to 41. The increase took place in the non certified population, 1 of the 11 Severe Injuries took place in a Safety Certified environment.
