This classification is quite small and saw a slight decline in Actual Payroll over the past year \$26.5M to \$25.7M . Approximately 28% of the payroll is safety certified.

The classification sustained 5 Severe Injuries in 2024 all of which took place in a non safety certified work environments.

This classification continues to show improvement in lowering claims costs. It currently resides in the 300% Risk Category. If this trend continues it will be reclassified to the 250% Risk Category.
